

Liss Parish Council Action Plan for 2017/2018

During the Council year 2017/18 Liss Parish Council will undertake the following actions:

- Maintain the open spaces for which the council is responsible, including the three recreation grounds, and facilities such as the Village Hall, to the required standard;
- Comment on all planning applications which fall within, and/or impact on the Parish of Liss;
- Represent the views and promote the interests of the parishioners of Liss, particularly in relation to East Hants District Council, the South Downs National Park and Hampshire County Council;
- Communicate with parishioners of Liss by maintaining an up-to-date website (www.lissparishcouncil.gov.uk), providing a Twitter feed (@LissCouncil) and other social media, and publishing Village Voice newsletters;
- Listen, investigate and respond to issues identified by the parishioners of Liss and, if appropriate, to signpost to the correct person/ organisation for resolution/ further progression;
- Deliver speedy decisions through 11 meetings off full Council per year;
- Maintain good financial practices, ensuring transparency and value for money.

Key projects for 2017/18 include:

- Progress the Pavilion project including finalising design, obtaining planning permission and undergoing a tender process;
- Provide an accessible toilet in the Village Hall;
- Complete the Neighbourhood Plan and publish a programme for implementing and monitoring;
- Complete the Liss Infrastructure Delivery Plan to identify priorities and to maximise the impact from planning proceeds on the community;
- Provide new play equipment at the Newman Collard Recreation Ground in partnership with the Newman Collard Trust;
- Commence a scheme to improve drainage at the Newman Collard playing fields in partnership with the Newman Collard Trust;
- Achieve attainment of the Foundation Level of the Local Council Award Scheme.
- Manage staff changes through good succession planning.
- Introduce the SAGE accounting system.
