The position provides a unique opportunity to get involved in the local community, from making decisions on priorities for spending funds from planning development in the village, helping to deliver agreed action plan commitments (whether youth provision or green space projects) to working on village centre and highways improvements.

You do not necessarily need to be a resident of Liss Forest.

You must be either:

- British; • A Commonwealth National; • An Irish or European Union citizen;
- 18 years of age or over,

and fulfil one or more of the following criteria:

1. being on and remaining on the register of electors for the parish: or, during the whole of the twelve months preceding the nomination;
2. have lived in, worked in or lived within three miles of the parish boundary.

You will be asked to confirm your eligibility for office.

Applications should include a short letter (and a CV if you have one) explaining why you should be considered for the vacancy to the Clerk via email or post.
