Liss Parish Council has two councillor vacancies

Liss Parish Council will seek to fill the vacancies by co-option at the meeting of Council on 16th October 2023.

10 of the 13 seats for Liss were filled at the May election and one councillor has since been co-opted, leaving two vacancies remaining (one for Liss and one for Liss Forest).

Could this be you? Are you interested in serving your local community?

The position provides a unique opportunity to get involved in the local community, from making decisions on priorities for spending funds from planning development in the village, helping to deliver agreed action plan commitments (whether youth provision or green space projects) to working on village centre and highways improvements.

You must be either:

• British; • A Commonwealth National; • An Irish or European Union citizen;

• 18 years of age or over,

and fulfil one or more of the following criteria:

1. being on and remaining on the register of electors for the parish: or, during the whole of the twelve months preceding the nomination;

2. have lived in, worked in or lived within

three miles of the parish boundary.

You will be asked to confirm your eligibility for office.
