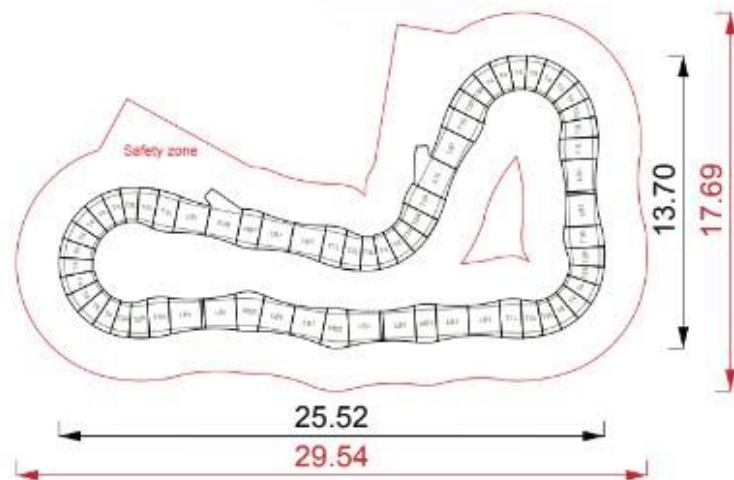


## Design C: World Cup 'continuous loop'

### Highlights

- The World Cup layout offers a total of 67 linear meters of riding.
- The track has one 20 meter straight made up of a series of rollers (bumps), three short rollers and four bends (also known as berms).
- The World Cup provides a good variety of straights and bends that turn in both directions, e.g., if you were riding the track clockwise, three bends turn right, and one bend turns left. This is useful because riders will learn to corner in both directions during each lap.
- Overall, the track has a nice flow, and the variety makes it fun to ride.
- Riders can complete multiple laps of the track. This means that riders can build speed from one lap to the next, progressing skill levels quickly.
- The track can of course always be ridden anti-clockwise to practice both left and right turns if so desired, providing everyone is riding in the same direction.
