



Villagers of the Year Awards 2025 Nominations

Liss Parish Council is seeking nominations for our annual “Villagers of the Year Awards”. These awards will be presented at the Annual Parish Meeting to be held on 19th March 2025. The 2025 Awards include categories specifically to recognise outstanding contributions made by the young people of Liss.

“**Villager of the Year**” is awarded to an individual in recognition of their contribution to the community of Liss. They must have given their time voluntarily to an organisation, group or the parish as a whole. It is open to candidates 17 years and above at 1 September.

“**Young Villager of the Year 6-11**” is awarded to a young person who deserving of recognition for making an outstanding contribution to the local community or they have achieved something special which is deserving of recognition or due to the general way in which they live their life is worthy of recognition. It is open to candidates between 6 and 11 years of age (inclusive at 1 September). Nominations may be made by anyone of any age but nominees must be sponsored by a qualifying adult – e.g. relative/youth group leader/teacher.

“**Young Villager of the Year 12-16**” is awarded to a young person who is deserving of recognition for making an outstanding contribution to the local community or they have achieved something special which is deserving of recognition or due to the general way in which they live their life is worthy of recognition. It is open to candidates between 12 and 16 years of age (inclusive at 1 September). Nominations may be made by anyone of any age but nominees must be sponsored by a qualifying adult – e.g. relative/youth group leader/teacher.
