At Memorial Green and on the surrounding roads, the aim is to create an improved setting where people can spend time and have easier access to the Triangle Centre. The proposals include:

- A new enhanced setting for the memorial by adding hedging, trees and seating. Informal crossing points and paved footways would lead to this space.
- Raised table at the Rake Road junction with a different surface to lower vehicle speeds and make crossing easier.
- Provide crossing points along Station Road and Mill Road.

- Continuous footways at the village centre car park entrance and the Old School Road junction. This junction would also be narrowed to make crossing easier.
- Gateway features introduced on Mill Road and Rake Road to welcome visitors into Liss and remind them to drive at an appropriate speed for the village centre.

Memorial Green Healthy Streets Scores

The Healthy Streets score has improved significantly from 22/100 to 60/100, representing a very good score by the standards of most modern streets.

All indicators have been improved on, with the biggest increases seen in 'Easy to cross', 'Places to stop and rest' and 'Things to see and do'.

These improvements are due to the new trees and shrubs, increase in seating and the proposed 20mph zone.
