



# Farncombe to Petersfield Re-signalling (F2P) Project



**14 SEPTEMBER 2022** 



### **Project Background**

- Signalling between Farncombe and Rowlands Castle on the Portsmouth Direct Line is controlled by three signal boxes – Farncombe, Haslemere and Petersfield
- F2P will replace existing signalling technology that dates back to the 1970s
- Control of the new system will be moved to Basingstoke Rail Operating Centre (ROC)
- Existing signalling assets are reaching the end of their serviceable lives and system is experiencing more and more faults as a result
- 9 level crossings and 3 foot crossings will be renewed/upgraded to improve reliability and safety


#### **Scope of the F2P project:**

- Renewing the signalling between Farncombe and Petersfield (ELR: WPH1 31m 60ch to 57MP)
- Decommission 3 Signal Boxes + Recontrol to BROC
- 90 new signals
- 17 new REB


- 6 new PSP + 17 new DNO
- 13 UTX + 18 URX
- Renewal 9 level crossings + 3 foot crossings


Start of Civils enabling works in Feb 2022 Blockade and continue throughout 2022 and 2023

Commissioning planned in Oct 2024







Scheme Fringe 31m40ch+-




