- Riders use the track at their own risk

- Elbow and knee pads are highly recommended
- Know your limits – don’t go too fast – parents consider if your child needs supervision
- No bikes with stabilizers or three wheeled scooters
- Do not use the track in poor weather – for example heavy rain
