

Riverside Walk gate

Background

Since the removal of the bollard at the station end of the Riverside Walk, there have been a number of occasions when vehicles have been spotted either driving up, or parked up the Riverside Walk, presenting health and safety concerns and damage to the environment.

At its meeting on 14th April 2025, Members of the Facilities Committee agreed that options for a gate at the entrance to the Riverside Walk should be investigated to prevent unauthorised vehicular access.

Three quotations have been sought for a gate to be positioned at the station end entrance to the Walk, leaving enough room for a vehicle to park up at the entrance to the walk if required, and enough access space for a double buggy or wheelchair to pass through.
